CHICKEN BLEED & RABBIT CLINIC

All birds must be NPIP certified or be bled at the chicken bleed. The LDAF tech wanted me to remind everyone that if your poultry is known to be sick, please do not bring them and expose them to the other birds. During the chicken bleed, we will also be doing health papers free of cost for our exhibitors. If you are NPIP and choose not to attend the clinic, you will still need to get health papers from a vet. The chicken bleed will start at 5:30 on January 8th and either be in the office or the 4-H barn depending on weather.

January 5 – Deadline for participants to enter broilers in 4-H Online.

January 10 – Deadline to enter broilers and exhibition birds in registration site, Fair Entry. You have to do this in order to show.

January 21 – Meat Pens Due in 4-H Online

February 8 – State Rabbit Entries Due – Fair Entry

A registration link was emailed through 4-H Online. Fair Entry Registration is open now and closes midnight **1/10/2026**. \$15 fee per pen of broilers and \$5 fee per bird for exhibition birds. Online payment is the only option.

FELICIANA LIVESTOCK SHOW

This year the Feliciana Livestock Show will be held at the 4-H Barn on Friday, January 16 & Saturday, January 17. Animals will move in on Thursday, January 15, except for chickens and rabbits. Exhibitors should refer to the show schedule for start times. All who you would like to come to watch the show are welcome to do so! SOUTH CENTRAL LIVESTOCK SHOW

The South Central Livestock Show will be held at St. Tammany Parish Fairgrounds starting Wednesday, January 28, 2026, and continues through Sunday, January 31, 2026. A separate District Poultry and Rabbit Show will take place on January 28, 2026. Because we will be at a different locations, we will allow animals to come in on Wednesday January 28th beginning at 9am until 10 pm that night. They will still have the option to come in Thursday morning. Please see the show schedule for show times.
