How to enroll with 4HOnline

Scan QR code or type in v2.4honline.com in your internet browser then complete steps



- Step 2 – Enter address for family
- Step 3 – Click “Member List” on the left side menu
- Step 4 – Select 4-H, then click Next
- Step 5 – Fill out member information
 - Do not put email address for member unless it is different than the “family” email address
- Step 6 – Click “I want to join LA 4-H as a new or returning youth”, then click finish
- Step 7 – Select Units – this is your club selection. You can select more than one, but your school club/Member At Large/Quatrefoil should always be the primary club.
- Step 8 – Select projects – this is an area of interest, or you may select general/undecided. Then click Next.
- Step 9 – Scroll down to fill out all remaining “required” info.
 - Parent info – Even if you are the emergency contact, you will reenter your information here
 - Select your school from the list or if it is not on the list, click “unable to locate” and fill in
 - Select military affiliation. Click Next
- Step 10 – Fill in Allergies, Conditions, and Medical Release. Click Next
- Step 11 – Complete Hold Harmless, Media Release and Youth Code of Conduct. Click Next
- Step 12 – Click “Pay by Check”. This is the only option even if you are paying through PayPal or your school. Click next.
- Step 13 – Review information and click “Submit”. Your enrollment is now complete.
***If you are enrolling additional family members, you will click “Add Member” and repeat steps 4-13.
