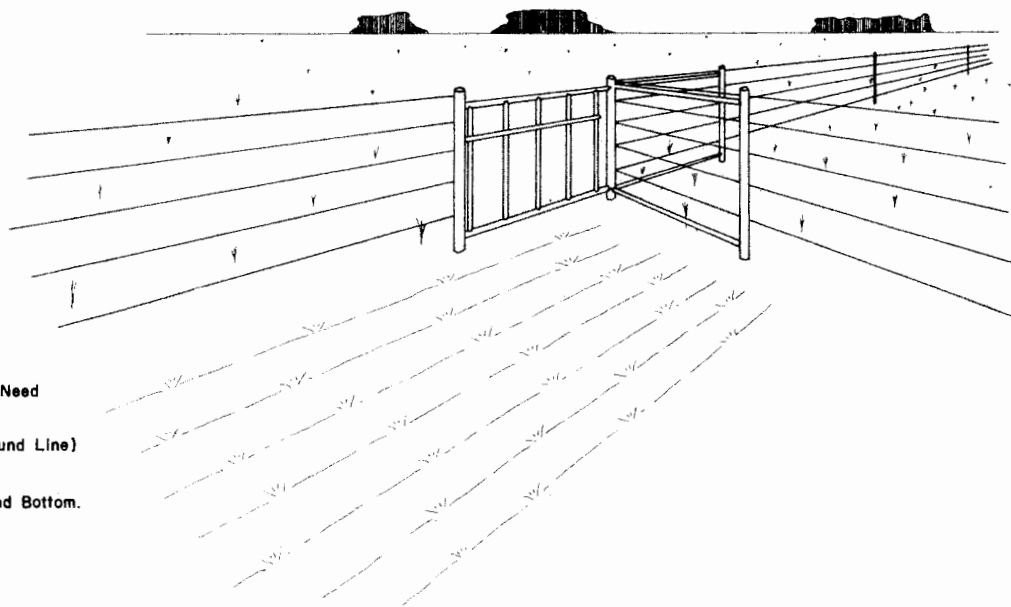
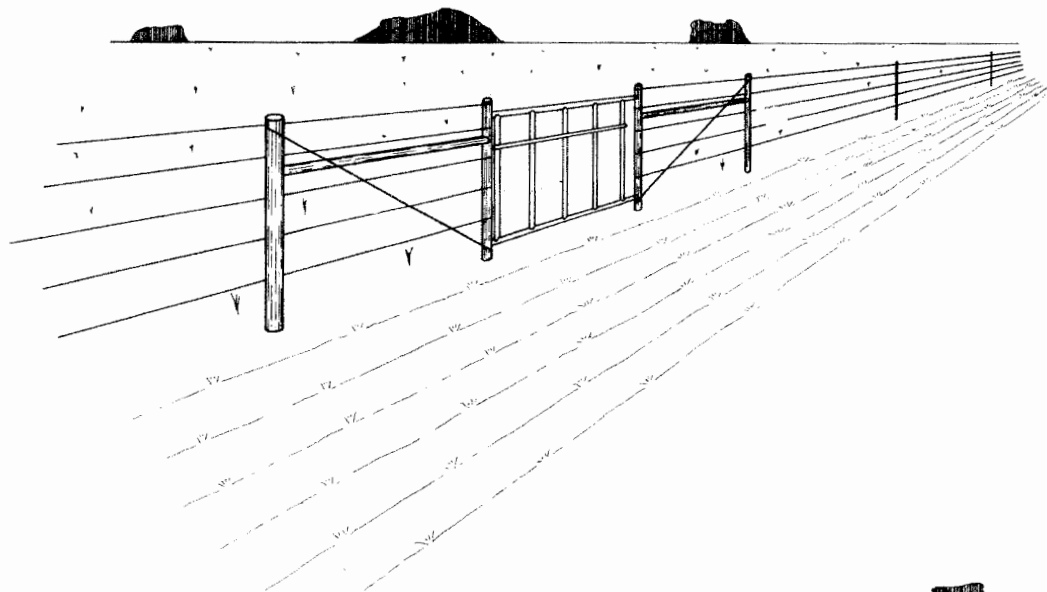




NOTES:

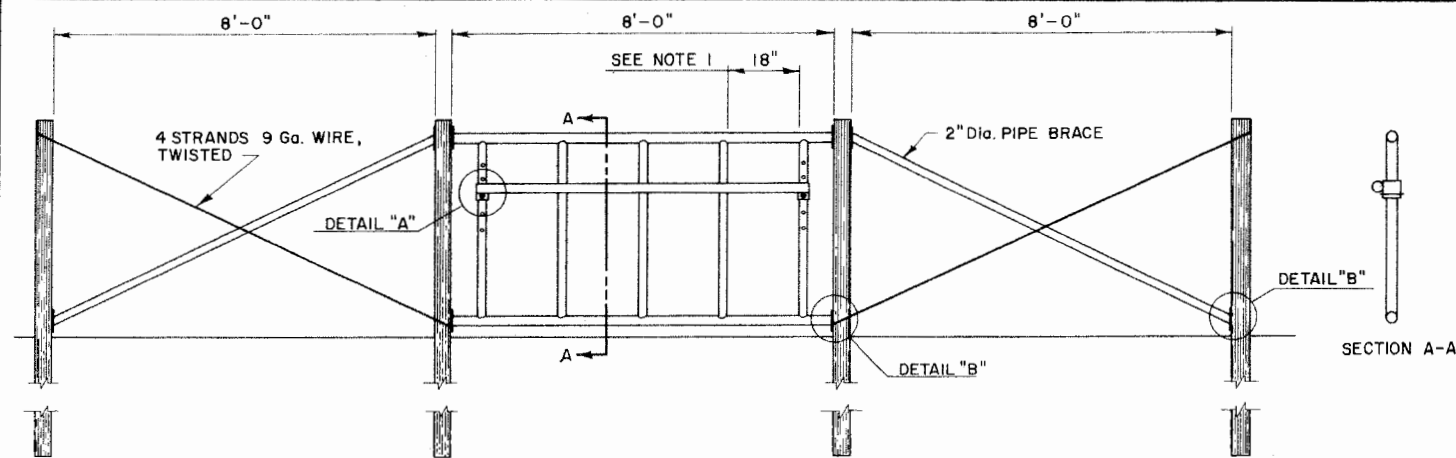
1. 18" Wide Is Generally Acceptable For Calves Up To 600 Lbs. This May Need To Be Varied For Your Specific Requirements.
2. Horizontal Bar To Be Adjustable From 24" To 48" (Measured From Ground Line) In 4" Increments. A Second Bar Is Required To Block Gate Completely.
3. Provide A Latch Post With The Capability To Latch Gate At Both Top And Bottom.
4. P.P.T. = Pressure Preservative Treated

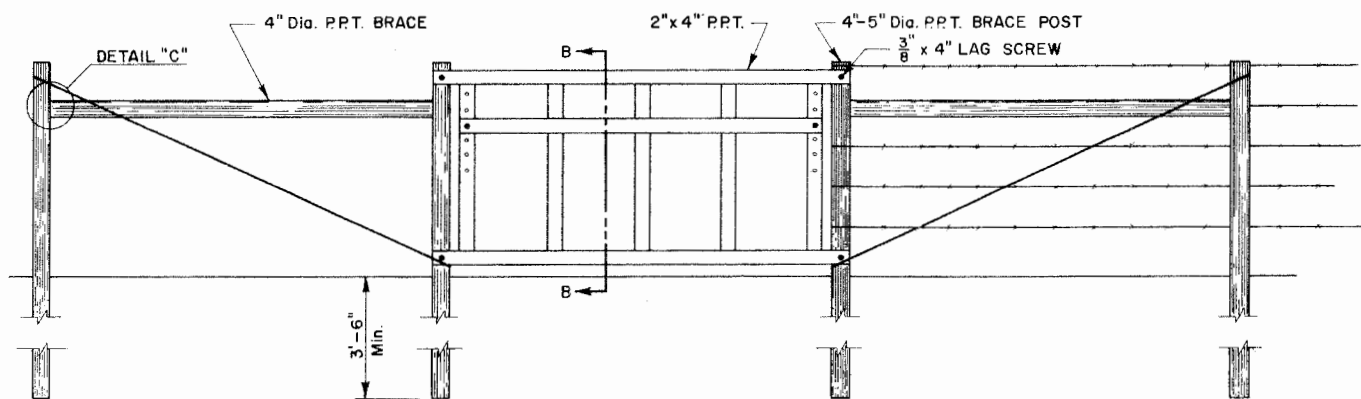

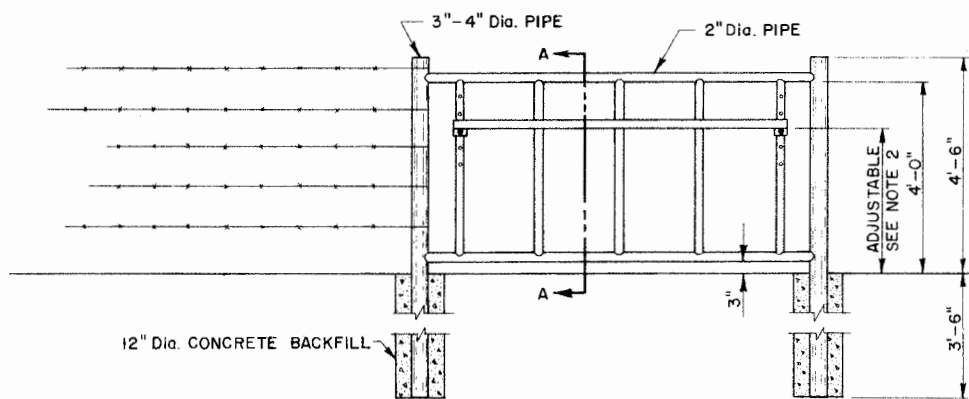

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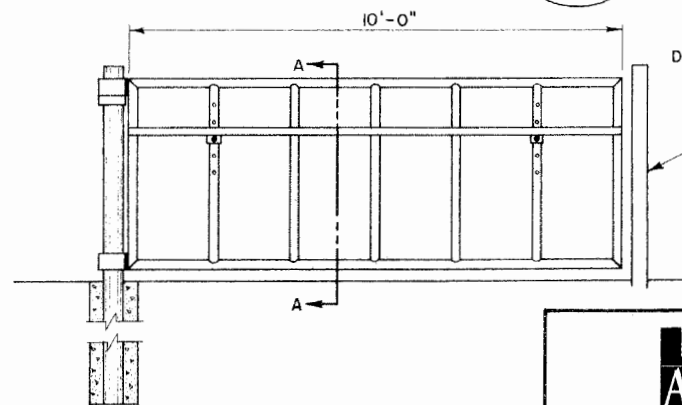
TYPE 1 - METAL & WOOD CONSTRUCTION
STRETCH POST ASSEMBLY



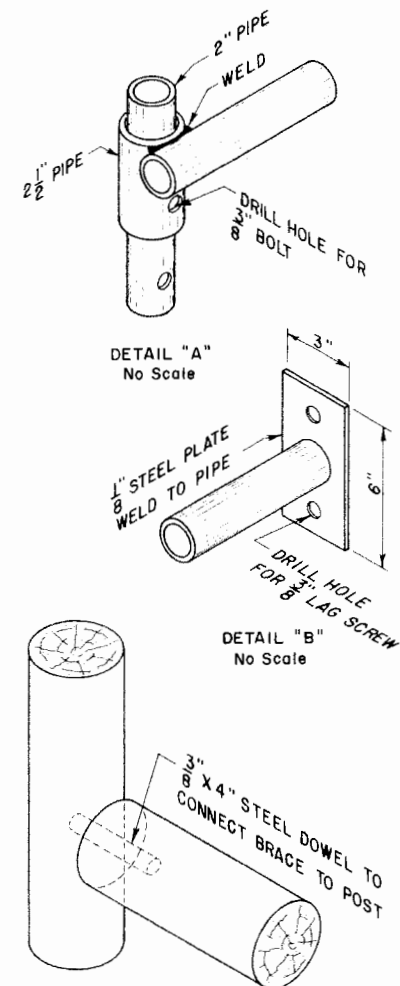
TYPE 2 - WOOD CONSTRUCTION
