

Inspections and Maintenance

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Essential Portion of Plan

- ✦ Inspections to be made every 7 days
- ✦ Or every 14 days and after every half inch rain.
- ✦ Inspections to be made by qualified personnel. One knowledgeable in erosion control and possessing the skills to assess conditions that might impact storm water controls and discharges.

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- ◆ Inspections to include all areas of site.
 - ◆ Control measures to be evaluated for effectiveness.
 - ◆ Required maintenance to be indicated.
 - ◆ Entry and exit points to be checked for vehicles tracking sediment off-site.

Reports

- ◆ Each inspection to have a report
- ◆ Report to be dated, contain names, titles and qualifications of inspectors.
- ◆ Weather information since last inspection.
- ◆ Locations of discharges of sediment or other pollutants.
- ◆ Locations of BMPs needing to be maintained.

Reports Cont'd

- ◆ Locations of BMPs that failed.
- ◆ Locations where additional BMPs are needed.
- ◆ Corrective actions needed, including changes to SWPPP.
- ◆ Reports to be maintained for 3 years after permit expires or is terminated.



















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
