4-H CLUB BANNERS:

SKIT SHOWCASE:

Each club is encouraged to have a skit to preform at Achievement Day. SKITS should be preformed by a group from the club; not individual skits. Fifty percent of your club should be involved in the skit; however, all members are encouraged to be involved. Each club is limited to one skit which should last 5-10 min.

SONG AND YELL CONTEST:

Each club is encouraged to prepare a 4-H Song and/or Yell to enter into the contest. Song and yells are separate contests. They will be judged on originality, quality, and unity.

CLUB SPIRIT AWARD:

The club with the most spirit has a chance to win this award. Some ways to win this award are: signs/banners/flags, members dressed alike, group cheering at appropriate times, showing respect, healthy attitudes, cheering and encouraging others, and designated areas and kept clean and neat.

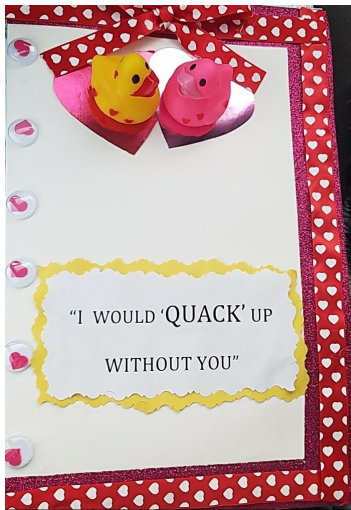
